Nicknamed "Coach Tower", this skyscraper sits at 10 Hudson Yard, in NYC. The building was designed by Kohn Pederson Fox, and is a part of the Hudson Yards urban renewal project, a plan to redevelop the Metropolitan Transportation Authority's West Side Yard. The skyscraper is named for it's main tenant, Coach, Inc..
